STUDY THE KOREAN LANGUAGE IN THE HEART OF SEOUL

During your ten-week-long visit to Seoul, you will join beginner-level Korean Language courses specially designed and developed for Asia Exchange students.

To complete this course, you will attend 80 hours of classroom lectures. Courses are taught for ten weeks, four days per week and 2 hours per day.

The program is supplemented by the textbook of the Seoul National University, the best university in Korea and currently ranked 29th best university in the world (QS Ranking)



THE CURRICULUM OF THE KOREAN LANGUAGE COURSE

Attend 1 – 6 eCampus courses during your semester in Seoul

In addition to the Korean Language Course, you can join up to 6 eCampus courses. All courses are taught in English and are worth 5 ECTS. Furthermore, distance learning lectures are conducted independently of time and location by professors and business experts worldwide. Please note that **if you would like to join more than 6 eCampus courses**, an additional charge of **199€ / 297USD will be charged**.

HOW DO THE LECTURES WORK?

The distance learning courses at the eCampus are hosted via Claned, an innovative distant learning platform from Finland, a country with the #1 education worldwide. You will have access to your individualized course boards in a highly engaging setup. It is the perfect tool for studying remotely as the eCampus enables social learning with interactive study material. In addition, you will receive progress reports and study behavior analytics.

After completing your eCampus courses, you will receive an academic transcript issued by Undiknas University. Additionally, you will receive a participation certificate for each completed distance learning course.
