INTERNATIONAL POLITICAL ECONOMICS (5 ECTS)

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This unit introduces students to theory, concepts, and philosophy related to international business. International Political Economy (IPE) is one of the studies that focused on economic and political issues. IPE study analyzes how the political forces affect the market dynamics and their implication on the political process. It also examines the interaction between domestic and international factors and the relationship between domestic political economy and foreign economic policy of a country. As well as the involved actors in the IPE study are states, markets, and societies.
