MEXICO STUDENT VISA

Foreigners who wish to remain in Mexico for a period greater than 180 days to attend courses, pursue studies, or conduct research projects at an educational institution belonging to the National Educational System in Mexico, must apply in person for a Student Temporary Resident Visa at the Consular Office closest to their place of residence.

You need to make an appointment via our free system MiConsulado: 1 (424) 309 0009 or <https://citas.sre.gob.mx>

REQUIREMENTS:

- A Mexico Visa Application Form.
- A valid passport or other travel documents.
- Photocopy of your passport.
- Passport-size pictures according to Mexico photo guidelines.
- Booked return travel ticket.
- Proof of sufficient financial means.
- Proof of accommodation.
- Employment status documents.
- Cover letter.
- Mexico visa fee.
- Any additional documents related to your purpose of travel.

All the documents you submit have to be in Spanish or in English. If they are not, they must be translated to Spanish by an authorized translator and both the original and the translation has to be included.

All the official documents have to be legalized. You can legalize documents via an Apostille Stamp or (if your country is not included in the Apostille Convention) at the Mexican embassy.

The Mexican embassy requests the right to request any additional documents as they see fit.
